3. Providing educational support to the needy children, giving them the materials needed, helping them throughout their process of education



4. Conducting awareness programmes, contests, seminars, discussions and other programmes in Schools and Colleges, both in Urban and Rural areas



5. Spending time with them on festival days, national holidays and other days held important in our country; celebrating and sharing the joy with them



- 6. providing medical assistance to the poor; especially for infants
- Joining hands with Private Service Organisations to organize Blood Donation Capms; organizing the members of PADIKKATTUGAL(StepS) to pull together a Blood Donors Group such that any emergency blood necessity could be met
- 8. Conducting entertainment programmes and utilizing the proceeds in providing necessities to the Homes
- 9. Teaching basics of living to Mentally Challenged children, imparting basic schooling, singing, dancing and other forms of art they may excel in
- 10. Aiding the visually challenged students by writing exams for them, gifting the physically challenged with things that will help them lead a life with comfort; a life where their physical difficult cannot hinder their achievements, helping out children affected with HIV

In toto, we at PADIKKATTUGAL(StepS) hope to remove from the Dictionary the word "Needy".



Who are those behind the screens here?

Stepping stones is an organization for every individual who wishes to help those in need, for those who envision a change for the betterment of this society. An organization founded by 2012 college passouts who are already in or about to enter into employment and college going students, Stepping Stones has in its folds college professors, Self employed entrepreneurs, Media personnel, Press people, engineering, medical and arts college students and software engineers from MNCs like TCS, INFOSYS, IBM, WIPRO, HCL, CTS, ZOHO, ACCENTURE, NOKIA, HTC like Mnc's And OTHER office Friends, etc. Each of these people for the pillars of this organization, supporting it and lending it the strength to stand tall.

We welcome everyone amidst us; friends, friends of friends, neighbors; it could be anyone; the only qualification is the passion to help those in need...



How do we join?

Interested people can join the PADIKKATTUGAL(StepS) as Members or as Volunteers.

What can Members Do?

- 1. Those members who are in or about to enter into employment, self employed entrepreneurs, friends, relatives and acquaintances may contribute a minimum amount of Rs.100/- to the Bank Account in the name of Stepping Stones. The amount can also be contributed in person, through friends, through internet banking, etc. The contributions have to be sent within the 10th of every month. Reminders and alerts will be sent through SMS and e-mails.
- 2. To monitor the contributions received, a Fund committee consisting of an Auditor, a Legal Adviser and our members will be constituted. Funds will be transfer only with the signature of atleast three members. Further, Fund Account, Receipts and Payments and other Accounting details shall be sent to every member through mail. A separate committee shall be constituted to take care of distributing the collected funds for proper purposes through proper channels.
- 3. Every person contributing Rs.100/- per month is eligible to become a member; every member shall have the right to take part in and supervise the day to day trust activities. Every member can lead; every member should contribute their effort and time. Receipts will be given for the amounts contributed on an annual basis; this receipt can be used to claim a percentage of such contribution as deduction for IT purposes. Every member shall receive through mail, details pertaining to contribution in hand, contributions received, contribution spent, contribution proposed to be spent in near future, purposes for which the contributions are to be used, contributions spent for procuring materials and other accounting

details. The same shall also be available in our website. This is to ensure transparency and promote accountability towards members and to provide them with confidence on the organisation's genuineness.

4. Contribution:- Contributions may be given either every month or cumulatively. For example as Rs.600/- every half year. Rs.100/- per month is a mandatory amount; higher amounts may be contributed at the convenience of the members. Receipts shall be given for the amounts contributed throughout the year at the end of every year. As stated before, contributions may be sent in through any of the methods mentioned above and receipts may be kept safe for future purposes.

What can Volunteers do?

Volunteers are not mandatorily required to contribute Rs.100/- per month; they can contribute any amount at their convenience, if they can. Generally, this group is for college students. They can involve themselves in non-monetary service providing, conducting classes, field work, etc. Expenses and reimbursements shall be provided to them from the Fund Account.
